Let's Go to Camp!!!

Exciting NEWS and opportunity for our youth from the Parish Ed committee. Church camp is just around the corner. As a committee, we are looking at different opportunities to raise extra funds to be added to "Cans for Camp" money to provide as much assistance to any family wanting to send their child to camp. As always if your confirmation-age child has not attended confirmation camp the church pays everything except a \$50 deposit. Families of confirmation-age kids have already heard from Bracy if your kid falls in this category. However, we are faithfully praying that we can broaden this generosity as much as possible. The outline below is the camps per grade level we used to calculate our goal. Please if you would like Bracy to get your kid registered reach out to her ASAP at 605-261-3080. Final amounts that are not covered by the church will be due at the arrival to camp.

*Kindergarten through 2nd grade at the Ingham location. A deposit of \$15 paid by the family with a total cost being \$42.

Dates available: June 19th, June 20th, July 10th, July 11th, July 17th, or July 18th

Kids would need to arrive at camp at 9:30 the morning of and the day ends at 4:30.

July 17 or 18 there is an opportunity for your child to ride with Bracy and Oliver. The date will be decided by which would allow more kids to go.

*Grades 3rd through 5th will have a family deposit of \$50 and the total cost would be \$179 before March 1st and \$209 after that date (at the Ingham location)

June 16-18 July 7-9 July 14-16

*6th Graders will have a family deposit of \$50 and the other \$50 will be paid by church. Total cost is \$399 before March 1st and \$429 after March 1st. (At Ingham location) Bracy will be taking her child to the session July 14-19 so arrangements can be made if your child would like to attend that week and transportation is needed.

June 16-21 July 7-12 July 14-19

*7th and 8th graders Deposit of \$50 other \$50 paid by church. Total before March 1st \$419 after it is \$449.

Ideally, we would like all the confirmation-age kids to go to the July 7-12 session at the Okoboji location, but if that doesn't work there is a session June 9-14th in Okoboji, or July 21-26 at the Ingham location
